- ⚽ Always respect the decisions of the match officials
- ⚽ Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- ⚽ Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- ⚽ Avoid bullying, intimidation and poor behaviour
- ⚽ Speak to my team-mates, the opposition and my coach / manager with respect
- ⚽ Ask my team captain to talk to the referee if I have a problem relating to the match
- ⚽ Remember we all make mistakes
- ⚽ Shake hands with the opposing team and the match officials at the end of every match
